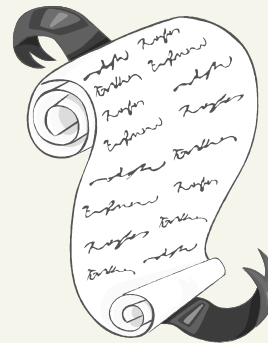
Each hour beginning at 2:30, one of our clients will share their testimony of how Boulware has helped change their life.

BOULWARE AWARDED IMPACT 100 GRANT

On October 27th, Boulware Mission and Owensboro Community & Technical College were name recipients of Impact 100 Owensboro's 2011 grants of \$103,500 each.

Boulware's project will allow continued renovation to the Mission's facility on Wing Avenue.

Currently, Boulware has the capability of housing 78 people (16 women and 62 men). Women live in the west wing of the ground floor and reside in dormitory-style rooms.

The men reside barracks-style in the Mission's east and west chapels. The 31 bunk beds that comprise their living quarters are extremely close together and provide for little personal space and/or dignity.

In addition, the Mission has only 3 showers available to all 62 men.

Sadly, many clients end up leaving the program early because they can't tolerate communal living any longer. When this happens, they are deprived of the tools they need to end the cycle they are in. The best results come from those who stay until they are mentally, financially, and emotionally ready to leave.

The money awarded through Impact 100 is designated to be used for the renovation of two living quarters and one bathroom upstairs. The project will more than double the current living space available. It will add 2 showers and 3 latrines and will allow enough space to add additional beds.

The beds located in the east chapel will be moved upstairs, while the west chapel will remain a living quarters for those who cannot physically climb the stairs each day. The east chapel will be returned to it's original use as a place of

worship and fellowship.

The Executive Board, staff, and residents are extremely grateful to Impact 100 for their gift.

This is the second grant awarded to Boulware from Impact 100 since it was founded in 2006. The first was in 2007 for renovation of the kitchen.

BOULWARE RECEIVES DONATION FROM HBAO

The Home Builders Association of Owensboro presented Boulware a check for \$7,500 on October 11th.

Boulware was selected to receive the contribution after a successful HBAO fundraiser in September.

The HBAO wanted to do something to help the homeless of our community work towards a new start on life.

Because it is unrestricted, the donation will be used to help pay operating costs for the Mission.

Many of the grants received

by Boulware are ear-marked for a specific purpose or project.

Unrestricted monies are always a need as the shelter has numerous monthly expenses; including: mortgage payments; electricity, gas, & water; food; telephone; internet & cable; computers, printing, and general office expenses; staff salaries and more.

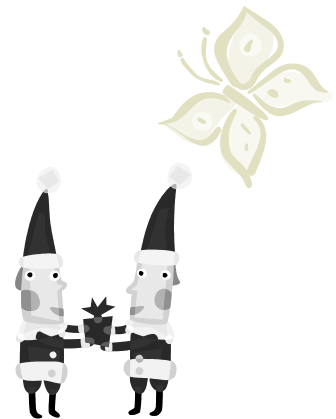
Boulware Mission provides a caring, compassionate “Home for New
