## Consolidation continues at Wing Avenue Campus

Boulware will be closing its Hall St. Campus consolidating all services at the Wing Ave campus in the near future. In the consolidation there will be an increase in clients served with no change in services. This will allow us to save substantial operational expenses in these difficult economic times. Having the administrative staff and case managers located in one building will increase operational efficiency and improve client management.

The long range goal is to renovate the Hall St building and return it to use later determined by the Boulware Mission Board of Directors. In the meantime we are looking for an

organization to rent the building for a use consistent with Boulware's mission.

The renovation at Wing Ave includes "the women's wing", additional dining area, administrative office space, relocation of the security office and main entrance and expanded food storage areas. Installation of electricity, overhead lights, heating/cooling units, as well as cleaning, painting and furnishing the expanded area is in
